Who is the course designed for?

Project Managers, Team Managers and Project Support members will benefit from attending the course by understanding many project management aspects that the PRINCE2® method does not cover in depth.

What are the course objectives?

- Build on project management context and knowledge gained from PRINCE2®
- Understand the concepts, techniques and processes in APMP for PRINCE2®
- Appreciate business processes and lifecycle models for projects and project management
- Use critical path analysis techniques and manage resource conflicts
- Select and apply appropriate project monitoring and control methods
- Use a systematic approach to analysing and planning a project
- Consider and apply appropriate conflict management and negotiating techniques
- Appreciate the project context and actively manage the project stakeholders
- Apply work breakdown structures and map responsibilities
- Recognise the importance of developing effective leadership skills and communication techniques
- Prepare for the APMP for PRINCE2® Practitioners 2 hour written exam.

What is the course approach?

This event is a mixture of delivery and practical sessions, delivered by an APM and PRINCE2® approved trainer. All trainers have practical experience of projects. Practical sessions are on an individual and team basis and feature throughout the event. The examination is taken during the afternoon of day three and the results are usually available from the APM within six weeks.

Are there any pre-requisites?

Candidates must hold a current PRINCE2® Registered Practitioners certificate to qualify for the APMP for PRINCE2® Practitioners exam. If your Registered Practitioner certificate has expired, you should contact SPOCE to discuss options for re-registering. Options include self-study e-learning and classroom training options.

What exams are taken on the course?

The APMP for PRINCE2® Practitioners exam is a two hour essay-style paper that recognises prior learning for current PRINCE2® Registered Practitioners. In this paper, candidates must answer six from ten questions covering 25 topics. The pass mark is 55%.
