

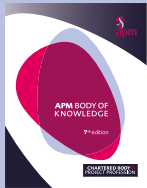

- Increased understanding, helping you to work more effectively



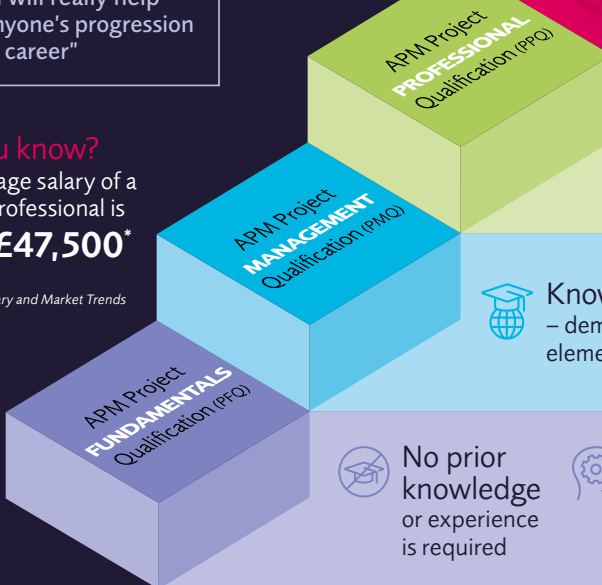
