About the Course

This two day practical course is designed to show you how to adopt and adapt the ITIL service management framework so you can make beneficial change within your organisation.

To sit the exam, delegates must hold a current ITIL Foundation certificate. The ITIL Practitioner is worth three credits towards the ITIL Expert qualification.

Designed for

- IT Managers or Practitioners involved in the strategy, design, implementation and ongoing delivery of business-used IT services.
- Individuals requiring an insight into Service Management best practice.
- anyone involved in provision, support, and delivery of IT Services.

Pre-requisites

This course assumes a knowledge of ITIL and ITSM to Foundation level supported by a current ITIL Foundation certificate.

Exams

Practitioner: 2 hour, 15 mins, open-book. Scenario-based 40 multiple-choice questions. Required pass mark 70% (28/40).

Passing the exam will give you an internationally recognised professional qualification, and is a pre-requisite for further courses and study in ITIL..
